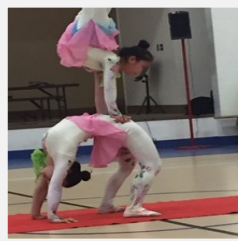

OPEN HOUSE FOR OPEN ENROLLMENT ON MARCH 5th

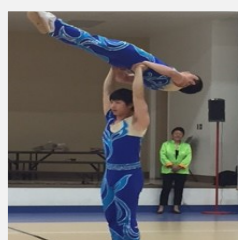
The school will be open after Masses on March 5th for any parents, grandparents or members of the community who would like to visit the school. The Catholic Daughters will be having their monthly coffee and
